

BBBC - Board Member or District Officer Resignation

Anyone who seeks or accepts a position on the to the Board should do so with full knowledge of and appreciation for the investment in time, effort, and dedication expected of all Board members and that the citizen's intent is to serve a full term of office.

However, if, for reasons of health, change in domicile, or any other compelling reason a member does decide to terminate service, the Board requests a 90 day notification of intent to resign so that the Board may plan appropriately for a replacement. A letter of resignation should be sent to and accepted by the Board chairperson.
